Excerpt from Policy JFCL A+ Scholarship Program

Program Goals

The district has established the following goals and performance standards and is committed to ensuring that:

1. All students graduate from high school.

• The graduation rate will increase or be maintained at 90 percent or higher.

2. All students complete a selection of high school studies that is challenging and for which there are identified learning expectations.

• Fifty percent or more of the district's juniors and seniors will enroll in advanced courses and/or vocational courses.

3. All students proceed from high school graduation to a college, postsecondary career-technical school, or high-wage job with workplace skill development opportunities.

• Smithville High School will maintain the percentage of students enrolling in all types of postsecondary education at or above 80 percent.
